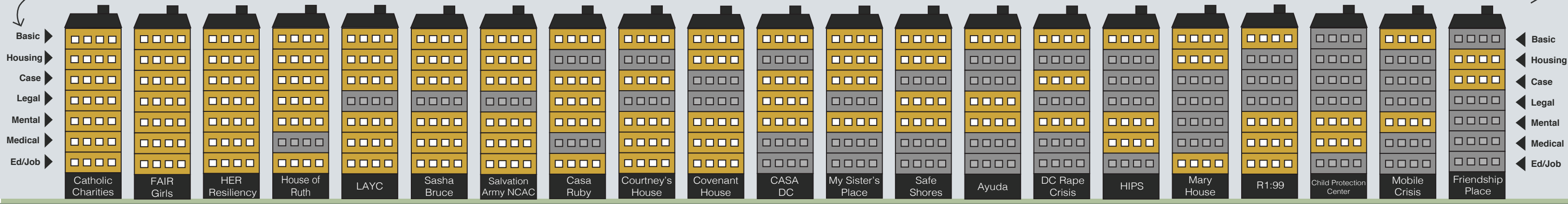


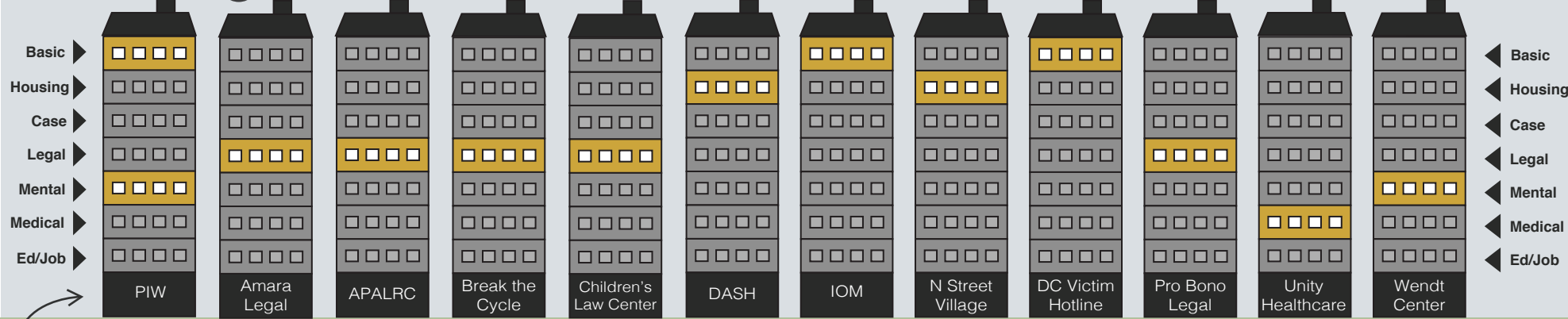
1 Locate categories of services needed

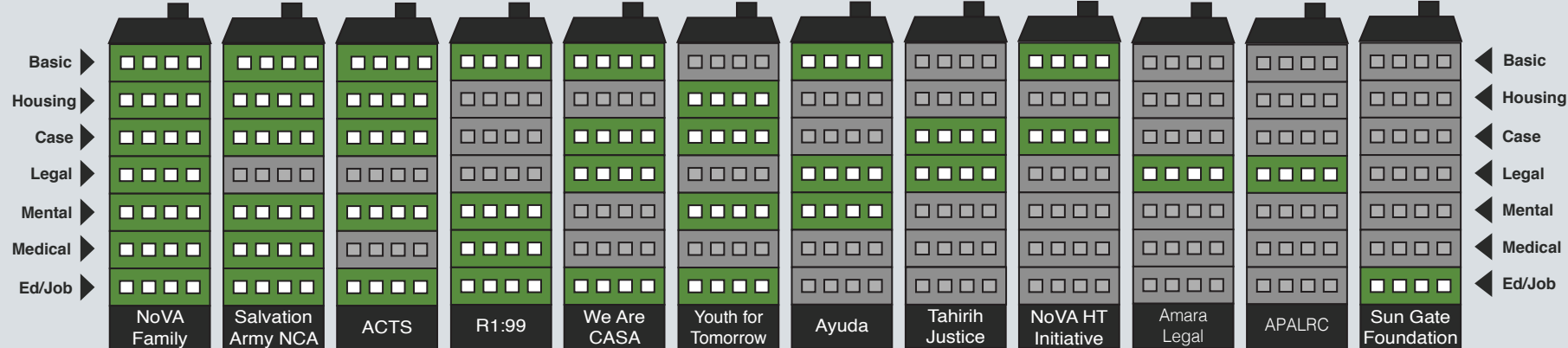

The Pocket Guide coupled with the online directory (www.DCHTResources.com) showcase the collection of networks within DC that have an enormous potential to improve our nation's capacity to combat human trafficking and to serve the victims in our capital city. Each building represents a direct service provider in the DC Metro Area. Buildings are ordered from left to right by the number of service categories offered, with the most comprehensive (largest number of service categories) organizations starting on the left to most specialized (least number of service categories) to the right. Please note, many of these service providers will respond to victims beyond their physical location. This is DC HTTF's first effort at mapping service providers in the DC Metro Area. As such, this may not be an exhaustive list, and is a constantly evolving directory.

How to use this guide:

- 1 Locate categories of services needed.** Colored bars on each building indicate the categories of services offered. The service areas covered in this guide include: Basic Necessities, Housing Services, Case Management, Legal Services, Mental Health Services, Medical/Dental Services, and Education/Job Training Services.
- 2 Find the state in which services are needed.** States are separated in lanes, and organizations are sorted into these lanes according to their physical location(s). States are color-coded as follows: **Virginia**; **Washington, DC**; **Maryland**. Note: some organizations may provide services outside of their physical location.
- 3 Flip to the back of this resource guide to find detailed information on the organization, including contact information, hours of operation, and additional location details.**
